Prior to the start of each semester a list of buyback text books will be displayed on the CDU Bookshop website and in the Bookshop. Students can sell their books to the Bookshop during specific buy back periods.

### THE CDU BOOKSHOP BUY BACK SYSTEM WILL OPERATE UNDER THE FOLLOWING GUIDELINES 1 - 8

1. Charles Darwin University Bookshop will buy back second hand textbooks from CDU students during period prior to the start of each semester. The list of buybacks will be published after the [deadline for prescribed and recommended](#) textbooks from CDU lecturers and trainer.
2. Books should be complete and clean and with no ripped pages. CDU Bookshop reserves the right to refuse buy back without comment.
3. CDU Bookshop will buy back the current edition of a prescribed text that has been confirmed for use in the following semester. They will not include text packs, or texts with CDs and/or passwords. Quotas will apply to all buy back titles.
4. The Buy Back price will be set by the CDU Bookshop. CDU Bookshop will offer students 33% of the CDU Bookshop recommended retail price for each title and the 2nd hand book will be offered for sale at 66% of the RRP.
5. CDU student ID card must be presented when selling buyback textbooks to the Bookshop. Contact details of all sellers may be recorded.
6. 2nd hand text books will be available to all students on a first come first serve basis. Our online order system does not allow us to reserve, special order or hold 2nd hand textbooks.
7. 2nd hand textbook sales will be firm sale.
8. 2nd hand text books cannot be bought or sold via the CDU Bookshop online selling website.
