



HEALTH AND SAFETY REPRESENTATIVE (HSR) TRAINING NOW AVAILABLE

This training is designed to ensure that Health and Safety Representatives have the required understanding of their role and are equipped with the necessary skills to perform the functions as defined by the NT Occupational Health and Safety Act 2007.

Duration:

This course is a mandatory 5 day intensive course that can be split up as follows:

- 5 days Monday to Friday or
- 3 days week 1, and 2 days week 2

Course Overview:

This 5 day practical, skills-oriented course is designed to provide Occupational Health and Safety representatives with the necessary skills and knowledge to compliment their roles in the workplace. The course will cover

- Introduction to OHS
- NT OHS legislative framework/OHS Duties
- HSR functions and powers
- Hazard identification and management
- Manual handling
- Consultation and conflict resolution
- Health and Safety committees
- Case studies and scenarios
- Accident notification and Investigations

On completion of 5 day training course participants will be issued with a Statement of Completion.
