DESCRIPTION

This is a trade qualification for plumbers in residential, industrial and commercial workplaces who are responsible for assembling, installing and maintaining water services, sanitary plumbing and sanitary drainage, gas and roofing in both existing and new constructions.

This is a licenced occupation. State and territory jurisdictions may have different licensing, legislative, regulatory or certification requirements. Relevant state and territory regulatory authorities should be consulted to confirm those requirements.

This qualification is suitable for an Australian Apprenticeship pathway.

STUDY AND CAREER PATHWAYS

Students will need to apply for Provisional gas fitter license when undertaking any live gas fitting work.
