

VTP276 Licence to Operate a Forklift Truck

DESCRIPTION

This unit specifies the outcomes required for the operation of a powered industrial truck equipped with a mast and an elevating load carriage to which is attached a pair of fork arms or other attachment, for licensing purposes. This definition also includes a truck on which the operator is raised with the attachment for order-picking.

ELIGIBILITY/ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

To ensure you have the right skills and support to succeed in your course, a Language, Literacy and Numeracy (LL&N) evaluation helps identify any areas where you may need additional support to help you achieve your goals.

To gain entry into VTP276 Licence to Operate a Forklift Truck candidates require:

- Legal requirements – Appropriate driver’s licence to operate in public places
- 18 Years of age if requiring a Forklift Truck Licence
- Hat
- High Visibility clothing (if possible)
- Sturdy enclosed shoes
- Sound L&N skills
- Unique Student Identifier (USI)
