# FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

In 2010 Charles Darwin University has a variety of scholarships to offer students studying in Higher Education or Vocational Education and Training (VET).

**CDU scholarships are sponsored by individuals, businesses, government, community groups and the University to assist students with the financial burden of studying. A number of the scholarships offer students the opportunity to participate in paid work experience during semester breaks and graduate positions on completion of study.**

**Applying for a scholarship is easy, especially if you are aware of the processes involved. This section will provide you with some of the more important information that you should know when applying for a scholarship with Charles Darwin University.**

## What scholarships are available?

Charles Darwin University scholarships are grouped into three main categories:

- **Scholarships for entry level students** – Available to new students who are applying for admission into Charles Darwin University to commence study in 2010.
- **Scholarships for enrolled students** – Available to new and continuing students enrolled or intending to enrol in a course with Charles Darwin University in 2010.
- **CDU Support & Equity Services Scholarships** – Available to new and continuing undergraduate students enrolled or intending to enrol in 2010 who can show financial disadvantage.

## How are scholarships awarded?

Each scholarship has its own eligibility criteria. Applicants must be able to address the criteria in their application and provide any supporting documentation requested on the application form. The applicant who best meets this eligibility criteria and who is approved by the Scholarship Selection Committee is offered the scholarship(s).

Eligibility requirements may include; academic merit, Grade Point Average (GPA) or Tertiary Entrance Rank (TER), equity criteria (financial hardship, sole parent/carer, medical condition/disability, Indigenous, etc), location (rural or isolated), personal attributes, performance at interview or a combination of these criteria.

## How do I apply for a scholarship?

1. Go to the scholarships webpage; [www.cdu.edu.au/scholarships](http://www.cdu.edu.au/scholarships)
2. Download the Scholarship Information Sheets for the scholarships that you would like to apply for and check that you meet the eligibility criteria.
3. Download the relevant application form and guidelines.
4. Complete your application, including all certified supporting documentation that is required and submit to the Scholarships Officer, Information Centre, Charles Darwin University, NT, 0909 or email [scholarships@cdu.edu.au](mailto:scholarships@cdu.edu.au) no later than the application closing date.

## EQUITY SCHOLARSHIPS

### Commencing or continuing student seeking financial assistance to study?

If you need financial assistance to afford university study and accommodation expenses, you may qualify for a CDU Support & Equity Services Scholarship. Please refer to page 7 for further information regarding Equity Scholarships available through CDU.

There are also Commonwealth Scholarships available from the Department of Employment, Education and Workplace Relations. ### When is my application due?

All applications must be submitted before the specified closing dates. Late applications will **NOT** be accepted.

### How do I know if my application has been received?

When you apply for a scholarship you will receive an acknowledgement letter in the mail stating that your application has been received. If you do not receive a confirmation within two weeks of the date that you submitted your application, please contact the Scholarships Officer.

## Can I have more than one scholarship?

In some instances students may be awarded more than one scholarship. This will depend on the eligibility criteria of the scholarships you are applying for. We recommend you apply for all of the scholarships that you are eligible for and in the event that you are offered more than one scholarship, and one states that you may not be in receipt of another scholarship, you will then need to make a decision of which scholarship to accept.

## When do I find out if I have been awarded a scholarship?

Whether you are successful or unsuccessful, you will receive a letter in the mail. The time in which you will receive this letter will depend on the scholarship you have applied for.

## If successful, when do I get paid?

You will be notified of the outcome of your application/s by mail. When you receive the letter acknowledging your success, you also will receive a scholarship agreement and a commercial-in-confidence form. Your scholarship money will be credited to your nominated bank account.

Scholarship payments are made within 30 days of the census dates in Semester 1 and Semester 2.

2010 Census dates are as follows:

Semester 1 – 31 March 2010

Semester 2 – 31 August 2010

Please note that applications for the Semester 1, 2010 Chief Minister's Study Scholarships for Women must be submitted by 3pm Friday 5 February 2010. Late applications will **NOT** be accepted.

Two scholarships from the Faculties of Education, Health and Science (EHS) and Law, Business and Arts (LBA) are awarded on academic merit to NT school leavers, based on TER.

## Vice-Chancellor's Prize

### Vice-Chancellor's Prize for High Achievement

Sector: **Higher Education**

Amount per annum: **\$6,000**

Duration: **1 year**

\* No application required

The Vice-Chancellor's Prize for High Achievement was established to recognise the achievements of selected Northern Territory school leavers who choose to study at Charles Darwin University.

Available to students of Australian Indigenous descent, who are enrolled or intending to enrol full time or part time in a Tertiary Enabling Program at Charles Darwin University in 2010. Students must also meet the low socio-economic status.

### Commonwealth Education Cost Scholarship - Ordinary

Sector: **Higher Education**

Amount per annum: **\$2,254 (\$1,127 per semester)**

Duration: **1 year**

Available to students of Australian Indigenous descent, who are enrolled or intending to enrol full time in an undergraduate course at Charles Darwin University in 2010. Students must also meet the low-socio economic status.

Available to students of Australian Indigenous descent, who are enrolled or intending to enrol full time and internally at Casuarina or Alice Springs campuses in a Tertiary Enabling Program or an undergraduate course at Charles Darwin University in 2010. Students must demonstrate that they have moved 100kms from a remote or regional location to take up their study and also meet the low socio-economic status.

## Indigenous Access Scholarship

Duration:	<b>One off payment</b>

Available to commencing students of Australian Indigenous descent, undertaking a Tertiary Enabling Program or an undergraduate course at Charles Darwin University in 2010. Students must also meet the low socio-economic status. Students who have already completed a higher education course will not be eligible to apply.

## Female Students

### Australian Federation of University Women Scholarships

Duration:	<b>1 year</b>

There are three scholarships available in the following categories of students; postgraduate research, undergraduate and indigenous. Students must be enrolled or intending to enrol at either Charles Darwin University or Batchelor Institute of Indigenous Tertiary Education.
