Fujitsu ACS Foundation IT Scholarship

Australian Computer Society Foundation was founded in 1966. Its objectives are to further the study, science and application of Information Technology; promote, develop and monitor competence in the practice of ICT by people and organisations; maintain and promote a Code of Ethics for members of the Society; define and promote standards of knowledge of ICT for members, promote the formulation of effective policies on ICT and related matters; extend the knowledge and understanding of ICT in the community; promote the benefits of membership of the Society and promote the benefits of employing members of the Society.

The Fujitsu ACS Foundation IT Scholarship is valued at \$2,000 for one year. The Scholarship can be used to assist with general education and living costs and will be paid in equal instalments of \$1,000 after each Census date in Semester 1 and Semester 2.

Recipients will receive a free 12 month student membership to ACS and will be encouraged to take part in the Young IT initiatives for the 2011 academic year.

Eligibility

The successful applicant will:

- Be enrolled or intending to enrol to study full time in the Diploma of Networking Engineering at Charles Darwin University in 2011;
- Be an Australian Citizen or permanent resident; and
- Have an appropriate academic record.

People of Australian Aboriginal or Torres Strait Island descent are strongly encouraged to apply.
