KFive Indigenous Scholarship

KFive has established, through Charles Darwin University Foundation, the KFive Indigenous Scholarship to encourage student participation at Charles Darwin University (CDU) and in the Territory workforce, particularly those of Australian Indigenous and Torres Strait Islander decent.

KFive recognises the importance of supporting Australian Indigenous and Torres Strait Islander people and encouraging education for people who may not otherwise have an opportunity without financial support.

The amount of the scholarship is \$1,000 paid in equal instalments after the census dates in Semester 1 and Semester 2, for two years or the remainder of the course, whichever is lesser and subject to confirmation of fulltime enrolment.

Eligibility

- The successful applicant will:
- Be enrolled or intending to enrol fulltime in a VET Course at Charles Darwin University;
- Be of Australian Indigenous or Torres Strait Islander decent; and
- Reside in the Northern Territory, and
- Be assessed on the basis of academic merit, personal qualities and reasons for undertaking the proposed study.
