TIO Remote Location Scholarship

The TIO Remote Location Scholarship has been established through the Charles Darwin University's Foundation to assist students in remote locations to study at Charles Darwin University.

TIO has been a long time supporter and sponsor of the Territory's only university, the Charles Darwin University. TIO Remote Location Scholarships are available to enrolled or intending to enrol in either Vocational Education and Training (VET) or Higher Education at Charles Darwin University, who reside in remote locations such as Maningrida, Tiwi Islands, Daly River, Wadeye etc.

The value of the TIO Remote Location Scholarships is \$1,500 for one year, payable in two equal instalments after the Semester 1 and 2 census date.

Eligibility

The successful applicants will:

- be current enrolled or intending to enrol in a VET or HE course at Charles Darwin University in 2011, who **do not** reside in the greater Darwin or Alice Springs area;
- have a consistent and appropriate academic record;
- be Australian citizens or permanent residents; and
- currently reside in the Northern Territory.

Employees and family members of employees of TIO who fit the eligibility criteria of this scholarship are encouraged to apply.
