# The Department of Chief Minister – Charles See Kee Multicultural Scholarship

The Department of Chief Minister – Charles See Kee Multicultural Scholarship offers support to students who wish to undertake study at Charles Darwin University (CDU). The Scholarship specifically aims to assist students with a humanitarian or refugee status from within the Northern Territory to undertake study to enhance their employment and general life outcomes.

### Value

The value of the scholarship is \$3,500 per annum. The Scholarship will be for the full time duration of the course up to a maximum of four years subject to satisfactory academic progression

### Eligibility

The successful recipient will:

- Be enrolled or intending to enrol in a HE course at CDU;
- Be an Australian Citizen or permanent resident;
- Be a resident of the Northern Territory;
- Be of a humanitarian or refugee status;
- Must maintain a satisfactory academic progress with no failed units.

The recipient must remain enrolled on continuing basis with at least 75% of the units studied internally.

The recipient is allowed to hold another externally funded scholarship or award tenable at Charles Darwin University.
