# City of Palmerston Scholarship

The Palmerston City Council Scholarship has been established through the Charles Darwin University's Foundation to assist a Palmerston resident studying at Charles Darwin University.

The scholarship is available to residents of Palmerston enrolled full time in either a Higher Education or Vocational Education and Training (VET) course at Charles Darwin University in 2010.

The value of the scholarship is \$1,000 for one year for a full time student, payable shortly after the census date in Semester 1.

### Eligibility

The successful applicant will:

- be enrolled or intending to enrol to study full time at Charles Darwin University in a Higher Education or Vocational, Education and Training course in 2011;
- have demonstrated passion, ability and initiative in their approach to their study;
- have demonstrated active relevant community involvement;
- be Australian citizen or permanent residents; and
- be a resident of Palmerston for 12 months prior to the application date.
