Lasseters Hospitality Scholarship

The Lasseters Hospitality Scholarship has been established to provide financial assistance to Alice Springs residents studying hospitality at Charles Darwin University. Currently Lasseters Hotel Casino and the Alice Springs Convention Centre employ no less than 230 people at any time of year.

This scholarship is available to enrolled or intending to enrol to study in a Vocational Education and Training (VET) Hospitality course at Charles Darwin University and who resides in Alice Springs.

The value of the Lasseters Hospitality Scholarship is \$1,000 for one year, payable shortly after the census date in Semester 1. Recipients may also be offered work experience during semester breaks and possible employment after the completion of their course.

Eligibility

The successful applicant will:

- Be enrolled or intending to enrol to study a VET Hospitality course at Charles Darwin University in 2011;
- Be a resident of Alice Springs;
- Have a consistent and appropriate academic record; and
- Be an Australian citizen or a permanent resident.
