Value

The value of the Scholarship is \$1,000 for one year payable shortly after the census date in Semester 1.

Eligibility

The successful applicant will:

- Be enrolled or intending to enrol full time or part time to study the Certificate IV in OH&S at Charles Darwin University in 2011;
- Be an Australian citizen or a permanent resident;
- Reside in the Northern Territory; and
- Be assessed on the reasons for undertaking the OH&S course, the benefits of how the study will contribute to the territory work force; and
- Provide a written statement displaying qualities of leadership, ambition and integrity.
