

Barbara Singer Environmental Studies Scholarship

The Northern Territory Office of Environment and Heritage has established, through the Charles Darwin University Foundation, the Barbara Singer Environmental Studies Scholarship to honour Ms Singer's contributions during a career spanning more than thirty years, to environmental protection throughout the Territory.

The scholarship is available to students enrolled full time in an environmental science course at Charles Darwin University. Applicants will be able to demonstrate passion, ability and initiative in the area of environmental protection.

The value of the scholarship is \$3,000 for one year to be paid in two equal instalments shortly after the census dates in Semester 1 and Semester 2.

Eligibility

The successful applicant will:

- be a current student enrolled or intending to enrol full time in an environmental science course at Charles Darwin University in 2010;
- have demonstrated passion, ability and initiative in promoting the aesthetic and/or environmental health of the Northern Territory environment;
- be Australian citizen or permanent residents; and
- have an appropriate academic record.
