

Cridlands MB Law Scholarship

Cridlands MB has donated funds to the Charles Darwin University Foundation for the University to establish the Cridlands MB Law Scholarship to encourage student participation at Charles Darwin University and in the Territory workforce.

The aim of the scholarship is to provide financial support, vacation employment and valuable introduction into private legal practice to the region's best and brightest.

The amount of the scholarship is \$10,000 over two years and will be paid in two equal instalments of \$2,500 shortly after census dates in Semester 1 and Semester 2. Payment is subject to full time enrolment and satisfactory academic progress, e.g. have not failed a unit and have achieved a credit average in the previous semester.

Cridlands MB will offer the recipient paid work placements in semester breaks with a temporary contract offered directly to the recipient.

Cridlands MB may in its discretion, offer to engage the recipient post graduation whether as an Articled Clerk or Graduate Clerk.

Eligibility

The successful applicant will:

- Be an enrolled third year full time student studying the Bachelor of Law or an enrolled second year full time student studying the Bachelor of Law (graduate entry) at Charles Darwin University;
- Be Australian citizen or a permanent resident;
- Reside or be prepared to reside in the Northern Territory;
- Be willing to undertake paid work placements at Cridlands MB during semester breaks;
- Be assessed on the basis of academic merit, personal qualities and reasons for undertaking the proposed study; and
- Be assessed on the basis of an interview.

People of Australian Indigenous or Torres Strait Islander decent are strongly encouraged to apply.
