

Flynn Family Fund Scholarship

The Flynn family has generously made a gift to the Charles Darwin University Foundation to establish a Dedicated Development Fund in support of a scholarship in the study area of Environmental Sciences

The value of the scholarship is \$5,000 for one year, which will be made up as two equal installments paid shortly after the census date in Semester 1 and Semester 2, 2010, subject to confirmation of enrolment.

The scholarship will be awarded as a "Merit and Equity" scholarship to encourage students who have the credentials but not necessarily the financial resources to continue their studies – the establishment of criteria and assessment of both these requirements will rest with the relevant Head of School.

Eligibility

The successful applicant will:

- be enrolled or intending to enrol in the Bachelor of Environmental Science (Environmental Management, BESEM) course at Charles Darwin University in 2010;
- be resident of the Northern Territory;
- be an Australian citizen or permanent resident; and
- have an appropriate academic record.
