

The George Brown Memorial Scholarship

The Darwin City Council has established, through the Charles Darwin University's Foundation, the George Brown Memorial Scholarship to honour George's contribution to the environmental development of Darwin.

The George Brown Memorial Scholarship is available to enrolled students in a horticulture, land management or environmental science course at Charles Darwin University.

The value of the scholarship is \$3,000 for one year, payable in two equal instalments shortly after the census date in Semester 1 and Semester 2. The recipient will also be offered vocational employment with the Darwin City Council in semester breaks during the year of the scholarship.

Eligibility

The successful applicant will:

- be enrolled or intending to enrol in a horticulture, land management or environmental science course at Charles Darwin University;
- have demonstrated passion, ability and initiative in promoting the aesthetic and/or environmental health of the Darwin environment;
- be an Australian citizen or permanent resident; and
- have an appropriate academic record.

Applicants must also include written references as part of their application for the George Brown Memorial Scholarship.
