

Maddalozzo Engineering Scholarship

The Maddalozzo Engineering Scholarship has been established to provide financial assistance to students undertaking study in Civil Engineering through Charles Darwin University. The Maddalozzo Group supports Northern Territory residents who choose to study Civil Engineering, giving Scholarship recipients the opportunity to realise their potential through study at Charles Darwin University.

There are two Maddalozzo Scholarships to the value of \$2,500 each. The recipients of the Scholarship will receive \$1,000 as an account at the University Bookshop (to be used for textbooks) and a \$1,500 sum that will be paid directly toward fees for the year of enrolment by the census date in Semester 1, subject to confirmation of enrolment.

Full time students enrolled the Bachelor of Engineering, Civil Engineering stream are encouraged to apply.

Eligibility

The Successful applicant will:

- be enrolled in the civil engineering stream of the Bachelor of Engineering or Bachelor of Engineering double degree course at Charles Darwin university;
- not be in receipt of another scholarship or cadetship;
- be Australian citizens or permanent residents;
- have an appropriate academic record; and
- reside in the Northern Territory.
