

# NT Agricultural Association Scholarship

The NT Agricultural Association Scholarship has been established through the Charles Darwin University's Foundation to assist students studying at Charles Darwin University.

The scholarship is available to enrolled students studying a primary industry, horticulture or agricultural course at Charles Darwin University's Katherine Campus.

The value of the scholarship is \$455 to be paid shortly after the census date in Semester 1.

## Eligibility

The successful applicant will:

- be enrolled or intending to enrol at Charles Darwin University's Katherine Campus in a primary industry, horticulture or agricultural course in 2010;
- have demonstrated passion and determination to succeed in the areas of primary industry, horticulture or agriculture;
- be an Australian Citizen or a permanent resident; and
- be a resident of Northern Territory.

People of Australian Indigenous or Torres Strait Islander decent are strongly encouraged to apply.
