

# Northern Territory Library Scholarship

The Northern Territory Library has established, through Charles Darwin University Foundation, the Northern Territory Library Scholarship to encourage student participation at Charles Darwin University (CDU) and in the Territory workforce.

The mission of Northern Territory Library is to develop communities through the delivery of appropriate Library services for all Territorians by, connecting people to information, preserving NT documentary and cultural heritage and helping people learn.

The amount of the scholarship is \$4,000 for a fulltime student for one year or \$2,000 per year for two years part time subject to satisfactory academic progress, i.e. have not failed a unit and have achieved a Credit average in each semester of enrolment while receiving the scholarship.

If the Northern Territory Library wishes to offer the recipient paid project work placements in semester breaks a temporary contract will be offered directly to the recipient by the Northern Territory Library. The length, type of projects and remuneration will be dependent on the previous experience and qualifications of the recipient.

## Eligibility

The successful applicant will:

- be an enrolled or intending to enrol at Charles Darwin University studying the Graduate Diploma in Information and Knowledge Management;
- be an Australian citizen or a permanent resident;
- reside in the Northern Territory; and
- be assessed on the basis of academic merit and reasons for undertaking the proposed study.
