

Northern Territory Treasury Work Integrated Learning Scholarships in Economics or Accounting

The Northern Territory Work Integrated Learning Scholarship program is designed to encourage student participation at Charles Darwin University (CDU) and in the Territory workforce by providing financial assistance during the study semester and paid work experience during semester breaks.

The total value of the Scholarship is \$15,000 – if successful you will receive instalments of \$2,500 each semester subject to satisfactory performance (payable in 6 equal instalments over 3 years).

During your work placements with the Northern Territory Treasury you will receive an Administrative Officer level 2 salary (base level).

You will be employed on a temporary contract with the NTPS and your salary will be paid on a fortnightly basis. Further information regarding the terms of employment is available at http://www.ocpe.nt.gov.au/ntps_careers/working_in_ntps/pay_and_conditions

The program will help you gain valuable experience to benefit your future job prospects and assist you with your studies.

Eligibility Criteria

The successful applicant will:

- be enrolled to study at Charles Darwin University in the Bachelor of Commerce specialising in Accounting or Economics;
- be enrolled or intending to enrol to study full-time on a continuing basis with at least 75% of units studied internally;
- undertake paid work placements with Treasury for 6-12 weeks during semester breaks;
- be an Australian Citizen or permanent resident and must reside in the Northern Territory whilst in receipt of the scholarship; and
- not hold any other scholarship or award except with the written permission of the Director, Student Services.
