

SAP Australia Scholarship

SAP Australia has established, through Charles Darwin University Foundation, the SAP Australia Scholarship to encourage student participation at Charles Darwin University and in the Northern Territory workforce.

SAP is a leading provider of business software in Australia and internationally with strong links to NT business and the NT Government. SAP is committed to supporting the education of future IT professionals and in particular to the skilling up of Northern Territorian students in world class technology and best practice.

The amount of the scholarship is \$25,000 over 3 years and will be paid in 6 instalments. First year instalments of \$4,200 will be paid shortly after Census dates in Semester 1 and Semester 2, 2010. Second and third year instalments of \$4,150 will be paid shortly after Census dates in Semester 1 and Semester 2 of 2011 and 2012. Payments are subject to full time enrolment and satisfactory academic progress, e.g. have not failed a unit and have achieved a credit average in each semester whilst in receipt of the scholarship.

SAP Australia may provide the recipient with a mentor whilst in receipt of the scholarship. This will be negotiated directly between SAP Australia and the recipient.

Eligibility

The applicant will:

- have applied to study and intend to enrol full time in their first year of the Bachelor of Information Technology at Charles Darwin University;
- be a current resident of the Northern Territory at the time of application;
- be an Australian citizen; and
- be assessed on the basis of academic merit, demonstrated passion for Information Technology, involvement in the local community and reasons for undertaking the proposed study.
