Scholarship recipients may also be offered vocational employment at TIO and offered full time graduate employment at the completion of their course, subject to satisfactory performance.

Eligibility

The successful applicant will:

- be enrolled to study full time at Charles Darwin University in a Bachelor of Business/Commerce or Bachelor of Business/Commerce double degree program;
- be enrolled in their final year of study;
- have a consistent and appropriate academic record;
- be Australian citizen or permanent residents; and
- be a current resident of the Northern Territory.

Employees and family members of employees of TIO who meet the eligibility criteria of this scholarship are encouraged to apply.
