

# CUA40415 Certificate IV in Live Production and Technical Services



## DESCRIPTION

This qualification reflects the role of individuals working in a range of technical production jobs in the entertainment industry. They apply solutions to a defined range of unpredictable problems, and analyse and evaluate information from a variety of sources. They may provide leadership and guidance to others and have limited responsibility for the output of others.

## ELIGIBILITY/ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

To gain entry into CUA40415 Certificate IV in Live Production and Technical Services candidates are required:

- To have completed CUAWHS302 Follow occupational health and safety procedures or can demonstrate equivalence (additional training will be provided to candidates to ensure equivalency); and
- CPCCOHS2001A Apply OHS requirements, policies and procedures in the construction industry will be completed prior to commencement of the qualification as part of the delivery. This unit is a prerequisite to CPCCCM2010B Work safely at heights.

Are able to demonstrate technical production skills in at least one specialisation that supports learning at a Certificate IV level. A specialisation could comprise skills in at least one of the following areas:

- Information Technology
- Lighting
- Performing Arts
- Screen and Media
- Sound
- Staging
- Vision systems
- Theatre
- Music Technology

In particular, they must be able to provide evidence of their ability to:

- produce a body of work demonstrating the ability to respond effectively to workplace requirements associated with at least one specialisation in line with current industry standards;
- apply a basic knowledge of trends and traditions in at least one specialisation in technical production; and
- apply technical skills in at least one specialisation.

Those skills and knowledge may have been acquired through personal or work experience, or through formal study. All prerequisite qualifications and experience will be assessed at a pre-enrolment interview.

## DELIVERY DETAILS

Location (s)	Duration	Study mode
Casuarina	One (1) year full time and Two (2) years part time	This program will be delivered in workshops and on-site, at different entertainment venues. Training will be provided in mixed mode including classes and intensives.

## 2019 FEES

## ASSESSMENT

Assessments vary with each unit and include: evidence gathered from the workplace, written assignments and practical observation.

## RECOGNITION OF PRIOR LEARNING (RPL)

Students can apply for RPL during pre-enrolment or after enrolment. Students are provided with an RPL Self-Assessment before application and followed through with and an initial interview with an assessor.

## RESOURCES

Students are issued with learning materials and handouts for each unit. Students will also need to provide their own Personal Protective Equipment. This includes riggers gloves, closed shoes, safety glasses and ear plugs. It is recommended that students provide and carry a multi-tool pliers such as a Leatherman/Gerbe and a set of closed-back or over-ear headphones.
