

# CPC40920 Certificate IV in Plumbing and Services – Operations



## DESCRIPTION

This qualification gives graduates the opportunity to gain the requirements to obtain an advanced tradespersons license.

An advanced tradesperson's licence allows the holder to contract for plumbing and draining work in their own right. They may carry out plumbing and draining work themselves and/or direct and supervise the work of apprentices, journeymen and trades assistants

Infection control, including COVID-19 measures and the associated restrictions, have been implemented to ensure the safety and well-being of students, lecturing staff and the wider community.

## ELIGIBILITY/ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

To gain entry into CPC40920 Certificate IV in Plumbing and Services – Operations, candidates require:

- Completion of a relevant trade qualification or equivalent such as CPC32413 Cert III in Plumbing.
- An appropriate level of language, literacy and numeracy.
- Confident computer literacy.
- Completion of the NT White Card is required before entering a construction work site (CPCCCWHS1001 covers this requirement).

To ensure you have the right skills and support to succeed in your course, a Language, Literacy and Numeracy (LL&N) evaluation helps identify any areas where you may need additional support to help you achieve your goals.

## 2022 FEES

The 2022 indicative fee for this course is between \$2,201.50 - \$2,781.50 for eligible students and receive an NT Domestic Subsidised place or between \$12,500.00 - \$15,780.00 for Domestic Full fee places. Actual fees will vary according to your choice of units.
