# RII30820 Certificate III in Civil Construction Plant Operations

### **DESCRIPTION**

This qualification reflects the role of individuals working as skilled operators with civil construction plant, who apply a broad range of skills in varied work contexts, using some discretion and judgement and relevant theoretical knowledge. These individuals may provide theoretical advice and support a team.

Licensing, legislative and certification requirements that apply to this qualification can vary between states, territories, and industry sectors. Users must check requirements with the relevant body before applying the qualification.

- Understanding of basic computer skills, to navigate online learning materials and assessments.

Students can also undertake this course as non-apprentices.
