STUDY PLAN INFORMATION

The Bachelor of Midwifery (WMIDW1) is a progressive course with each study plan being designed to facilitate appropriate student progression (unit sequencing in the study plan builds upon the knowledge that should be obtained in a previous semester/year). The School advises all students to follow one of the study plans contained in this information package as any deviation is likely to increase the course duration. Any deviation from the study plan should be discussed with the ALU or the Midwifery course coordinator prior to enrolling in units to minimise the impact of any deviation. The complete degree via any pathway needs to be completed within eight years maximum time frame. In the following examples of pathways, if four units have not been nominated for each semester, this is due to prerequisite requirements. For part time pathways refer to Academic Learning Unit (ALU).

APPLICATION FOR EXEMPTION/ADVANCED STANDING/CREDIT TRANSFER

Students wishing to apply for advanced standing based on previous studies or incomplete studies from CDU or another institution are required to complete the HE113- Application for Exemption form which is located at <http://www.cdu.edu.au/studentportal/adminforms.html>. It is important to note that applications for advanced standing/credit transfer can take up to 3 weeks to be processed.

A certified copy of an academic transcript, key to grades and unit outlines (document detailing the learning outcomes and assessments) must be supplied with the completed form as applications without supporting documentation will not be processed. The University does not accept photocopied, faxed or scanned versions of a certified document. To identify the units for which the student is seeking credit (requirement of the HE113 form), access to these units is gained by clicking onto the CDU website and clicking on Courses (very top of main CDU page) and using the search box to locate the WMIDW1 course and units. The hyperlinks beside the units can be used to check the unit description.

ADVANCED STANDING/CREDIT TRANSFER FOR HOSPITAL TRAINED ENROLLED NURSES

In line with changes to both the national Australian Qualifications Framework and University Guidelines, applicants with the abovementioned qualifications should apply for Portfolio Assessment of their experience in professional development qualifications. Each applicant will be assessed on merit.
