### Additional Financial Assistance to HDR Students

### **HDR Student Conference Travel Grant**

The HDR Student Conference Travel Grant is available to HDR Students who require financial assistance to attend a domestic or international conference to present an accepted poster or paper. The grant is for up to \$2,000 and can contribute to costs of flights, accommodation and conference registration.

Eligibility criteria must be met to be considered for the grant. HDR Students are only eligible for one Conference Travel Grant during their candidature.

# External HDR Student/Supervisor Travel Grant

The External HDR Student/Supervisor Travel Grant is available to HDR Students and/or their supervisors who are based externally from CDU, Casuarina Campus. The grant is for up to \$2,000 and is to be used for travel either to Darwin or to where the student/supervisor is located.

Eligibility criteria must be met to be considered for the grant. HDR Students are only eligible for one External HDR Student/Supervisor Travel Grant per calendar year.

# HDR Student Supplementary Funding Grant

The HDR Student Supplementary Funding Grant is available to HDR Students who require extra financial assistance towards their research project. The grant is for up to \$5,000 and may be provided to cover an unexpected shortfall in funding to complete the project or to provide financial assistance for additional activities that will yield significant new research findings not anticipated when the substantive project was formulated.

Eligibility criteria must be met to be considered for the grant.

# HDR Student Development Course Grant

The HDR Student Development Course Grant may be utilised for the purposes of funding courses in Grant Writing, Project Management or Discipline Specific Analytical Tools and/or Techniques. The grant is for up to \$5,000 and the funding may not be utilised in relation to courses that are already available either during the HDR Research Enhancement Program, or through CDU on-line courses. Grant applications must include at least one current College of EITE HDR student as a chief applicant.

Eligibility criteria must be met to be considered for the grant.
