It is expected that your application should be prepared in a similar style and detail to a formal job application, and the selection criteria below are framed as they would be for a job application. There are places for up to 16 students on the field intensive. Places will be made available on a first-come basis for those who appropriately address the selection criteria in their applications. The unit coordinator will provide you with feedback on your CV and application, in support of the professional development focus of this unit.

### **PART A: Applicant Details**

Include the following information:

- Student name, postal address, mobile phone number, email address
- Gender
- Date of birth
- First language, other languages and level of skill in them
- Home university
- University student ID number
- Passport number, date of issue and expiry
- Name, email and phone number of a next of kin (someone you would like us to contact in the case of an emergency)

### **PART B: Education and Professional Experience**

Include the following:

- Academic Transcript (most recent)
- Curriculum Vitae
- Names and addresses of two referees, who can support your application to attend the field intensive, if required
- Address the selection criteria

Please provide up to half a page in response to each of the following selection criteria (include examples where possible)

- Excellent spoken and written communications skills.
- Experience or willingness to gain experience, working in a cross-cultural setting.
- Experience and qualifications in natural resources management and wildlife conservation
- Experience, or willingness to gain experience, working as a research associate
- Intention to apply the skills gained during the Brazil Amazon field intensive in subsequent academic and professional practice.

- You are invited to include any other information that you believe may be relevant in a covering letter.
