Darwin has a tropical climate with wet and dry seasons, but the average maximum temperature remains almost the same all year round.

72% of international students work while studying in Darwin, working an average of 17 hrs/week, make an average of \$24/hr on weekdays, \$26/hr on Saturdays, & \$29/hr on Sundays.

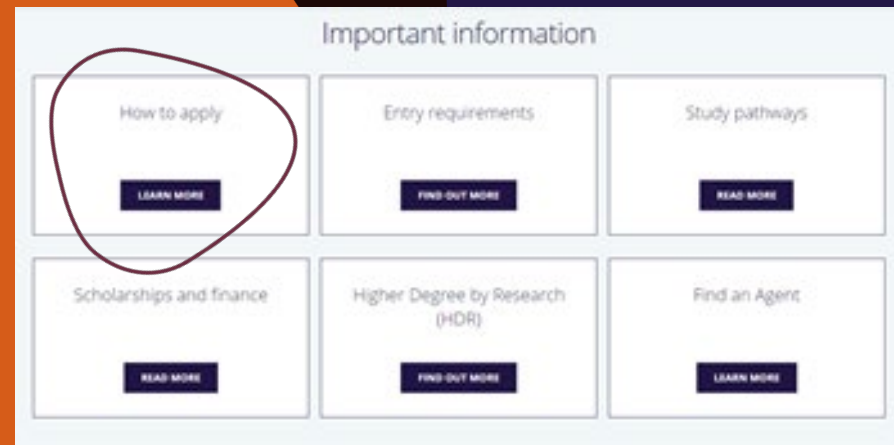
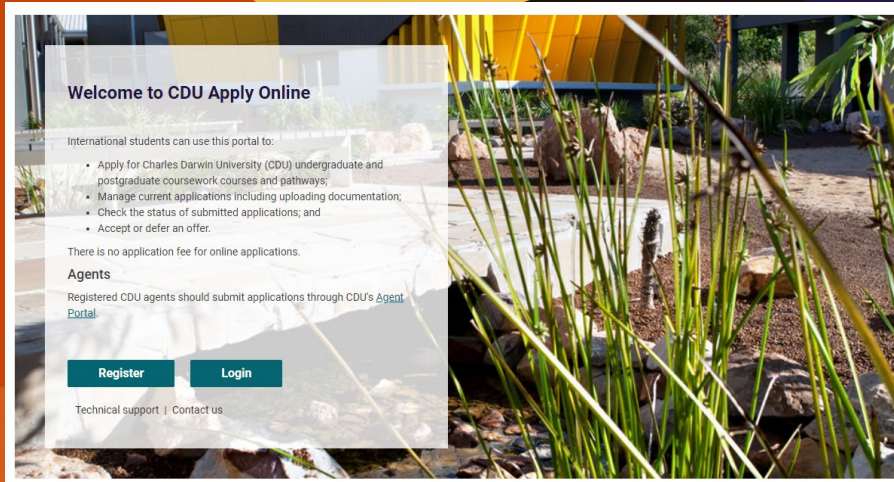

Steps to applying at CDU

The process to apply to study with us is simple, just follow these steps.

- Step 1: Find your course 
- Step 2: Check the academic and English entry requirements 
- Step 3: Check the application deadlines 
- Step 4: Apply for your course 
- Step 5: Application Assessment 
- Step 6: Offer 
- Step 7: Accept your offer 
- Step 8: Apply for your student visa 
- Step 9: Enrol 
- Step 10: Before you leave home 
- Step 11: Your arrival

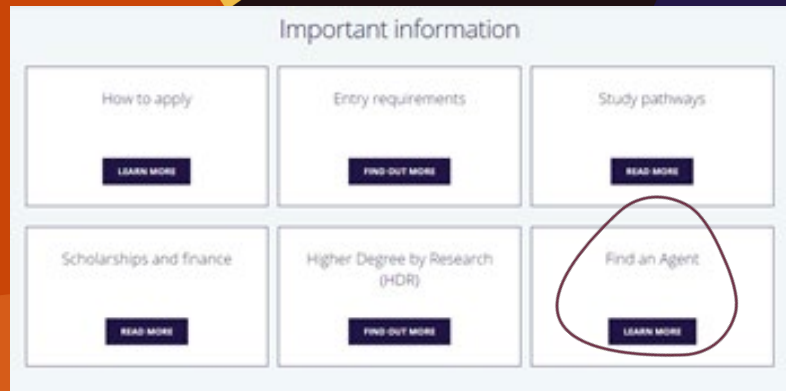
1. Apply through a CDU Agent – 52 countries
