Diploma of Arts

You have the flexibility to choose units from any of the specialist electives listed or to focus on one of nine thematic areas to suit your interests.  Thematic areas include:  - Communications, Literature and Digital Media - Society and Culture - Global Humanities in a Digital Age - Indigenous Governance and Policy - Contemporary Indigenous Australia - Languages and Linguistics - Creative and Digital Arts - Music Making, Production and Performance - Architectural Design
