## Masters Qualifying Programs

### Academic Entrance Requirements 2020

<b>Australia</b>	Hold a three year post-secondary (post-Year 12 equivalent) qualification OR hold a Bachelor degree (or equivalent) from a recognised University (or another tertiary education institution of equivalent standing) with a minimum GPA of 3.5 (on a 7-point scale)
<b>Bangladesh</b>	Honours Bachelor degree (3 years) awarded by a Section 1 institution Honours Bachelor degree (4 years) awarded by a Section 2 institution
<b>Bhutan</b>	Completion of a 3 year, full-time Bachelor Degree from Royal University of Bhutan, or one of its constituent Colleges or Institutions
<b>China</b>	Three year, post-secondary qualification from a recognised institution
<b>Hong Kong</b>	3 year post-secondary qualification, HND case by case
<b>India</b>	3 year Bachelor degree awarded in 3rd or Pass Division or Class by a Section 2 institution; or 3 year Bachelor degree awarded in 2nd, 3rd or Pass Division or Class by a Section 3 institution
<b>Indonesia</b>	A Sarjana (S1), awarded by a Section 1 institution in or after 1998 following a program identified as accredited by BAN-PT with a rating of C - at least eight semesters (four years) of full-time study (144-160 credits) Diploma III from Section 1. Three years full-time (110-120 credits) with minimum rating of A or B
<b>Japan</b>	3 year JCDs assessed by NOOSR as Cert IV or Diploma equivalent Not eligible for entry
<b>Kazakhstan</b>	No diplomas are eligible as they are assessed as equivalent to AQF 5
<b>Kenya</b>	Successful completion of a 3 year full-time Diploma from public university
<b>Macau</b>	Recognised first degree (honours/ordinary) and Higher Diplomas only Other three year qualifications case by case as per NOOSR guidelines
<b>Malaysia</b>	Recognised first degree, 4 year full-time Diploma or Advanced Diploma after SPM or a 3 - 4 year full time Diploma or Advanced Diploma after STPM as accredited by the Malaysian Qualifications Authority. A tertiary qualification at degree or equivalent level from a recognised institution/Advanced Diploma or other equivalent qualifications will be considered on a case-by-case basis
<b>Nepal</b>	3 year Bachelor degree awarded by a Section 1 institution at pass division or second division
<b>Nigeria</b>	Higher National Diploma (3 year full-time; or 2 year full-time, post National Diploma) from institutions accredited by the National Board of Technical Education
<b>Oman</b>	Completion of a Bachelor degree from a section 2 college of higher education 4 year duration with a final grade of 3.0, 75% or B
<b>Pakistan</b>	A Bachelor degree awarded by a Section 1 institution requiring three years of full-time study in any division or grade for a 3 year Bachelor An Honours Bachelor degree awarded by a section 2 institution in either the second or third division or with a letter grade of C or D requiring at least three years of full-time study

<b>Russian Federation</b>	Diploma o Nepochnom Vysshem Obrazovanii
<b>Singapore</b>	Recognised first degree, successful completion of an Advanced Diploma of 1 year full-time studies awarded by a Polytechnic and following a Polytechnic Diploma
<b>Saudi Arabia</b>	Bachelor degree from a Section 2 institution with grade of pass or good Bachelor degree from a Section 3 institution
<b>South Korea</b>	Completion of a Bachelor degree (Haksa)
<b>Sri Lanka</b>	Recognised first degree (40% plus) or 3 year Diploma or equivalent (55% plus)
<b>Taiwan</b>	Bachelor Degree of 2 or 3 years full-time completed after a Junior College Diploma in an unrelated field from a Section 1 university
<b>Thailand</b>	4 year Bachelor degree with final grade below 3.0 from a Section 2 Higher Education institution 3 year Associate Degree from Higher Education Section 1 institution; Higher Diploma of Technical or Vocational Education, or Associate Degree or Diploma of Vocational Education with GPA of 2.2 and above
<b>Turkey</b>	Recognised first degree (Lisans Diplomasi or Muhendis Diplomasi) GPA of 2.0 from all schools
<b>Uzbekistan</b>	Recognised first degree, Bakalavr, Specialist Diploma or Uzbek Diploma (4/5 years)
<b>United Arab Emirates</b>	Completion of a Bachelor degree from a section 2 or other licensed UAE instruction, 4 years full time with a grade below 3 out of 4
<b>Uzbekistan</b>	Certificate of Completed Secondary Education with 85% in 4 relevant subjects
<b>Vietnam</b>	A Bang Tot nghiep Dai hoc (University Graduation Diploma) awarded by a Section 2 institution with the title of Bang Cu nhan (Bachelor degree) or a professional title, such as Ky su (Engineer), or Bac si Y khoa (Physician) requiring four years of regular, full-time study (Chinh Quy)
