DESCRIPTION

This skill set reflects the skill requirements for providing person-centred support to people with disability in various settings.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

This skill set is for people working in various care and support roles in the community services sector who wish to develop skills in providing person-centred support to people with disability.

Students are required to have good reading and writing skills to be able to follow policies and procedures and documentation associated with their roles. Communication skills are important to communicate with the client, and they will have had experience in working within the team seeking clarification from their supervisors and following instructions

Alice Springs, Casuarina, Katherine	This skill set is delivered over a period of six (6) months part-time	Theory training is undertaken externally. Practical work is undertaken in a variety of community service settings where candidates are currently employed.

ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible for a free place, you must be:

- A resident in the Northern Territory, and
- An Australian Citizen or Permanent Resident or a New Zealand citizen resident in Australia for a minimum of six months or a Permanent Humanitarian visa holder, and
- At least 17 years of age (if you are 15 or 16 years of age, contact us and we'll assess your eligibility)
- Apply & Enrol by **30 June 2020**
