Like last year, CDU will be presenting regular workshops to HDR candidates and supervisors. This year, however, the workshops will cover eight themes, with various topics relating to those themes, as the following table delineates.

The workshops will include several features to engage participants, such as

- presentations from candidates or staff who discuss topics from the perspective of their culture
- debates and competitions, such as true and false questions, to attract points
- role plays, networking, magic tricks, and demonstrations

Recent advances and feedback from HDR candidates and supervisors will guide the precise topic of discussion during each session. Nevertheless, the following table outlines some of the topics that are likely to be discussed during each session.
