Information on how to enter and prizes are included in the conditions of entry below.

1. METHOD OF ENTRY

To enter, tickets can be purchased via CDU's online payment system Webpay. The cost per ticket is \$10.00.

2. COMPETITION PERIOD

The competition period is from Friday 21 May 2021 (8am) Australian Central Standard Time (ACST) and closes 4th of June 2021 (or once all tickets are sold).

3. THE COMPETITION:

• CDU Indigenous National fundraiser to compete in Newcastle at the Indigenous University Games known as 'Indigenous Nationals' in June 2021. Money raised through this raffle will support associated travel and participation costs for our current Indigenous students

4. CONDITIONS FOR VAILD ENTRY:

- Tickets is open to Australian residents only.
- Tickets will be deemed to be accepted at the time of receipt and not at the time of transmission.
- By lodging your contact details, you have agreed that you have read the terms and conditions that form a part of this competition
- Entries placed outside the competition period, as stated in these terms and conditions, will not be valid.
- The Promoter (Charles Darwin University), in its absolute discretion, reserves the right to verify the validity of all entries and to disqualify any entrant who tampers with the entry process, or submits an entry that is not in accordance with these conditions of entry.

- If the winner lives outside of Darwin, Northern Territory, the prize will be sent by registered post.
