

Applicants must provide further documentation in the form of a curriculum vitae (CV) that includes a statement of purpose addressing how the course will help you achieve your career aspirations.

Applicants who have completed the CDU International Masters Qualifying Program (ZMQP01) or the Accelerated International Masters Qualifying Program (ZAMQP1) are eligible for entry.

ENGLISH LANGUAGE

All international applicants must satisfy the University's English Language Proficiency Requirements for their chosen course of study. Applicants will be required to supply evidence of this at the time of application.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Successful completion of a recognised bachelor degree, graduate certificate, graduate diploma, masters degree or equivalent international qualification.

Applicants who do not have one of the above qualifications, but who have at least four years full time appropriate experience in management roles will also be considered.

Applicants must provide further documentation in the form of a curriculum vitae (CV), documented evidence from your employer detailing roles and responsibilities, and a statement of purpose addressing how the course will help you achieve your career aspirations.

Applicants who have completed the CDU International Masters Qualifying Program (ZMQP01) or the Accelerated International Masters Qualifying Program (ZAMQP1) are eligible for entry.

ABOUT THE COURSE

The Graduate Certificate of Business Research provides graduates with advanced business research skills that are relevant to contemporary commercial and academic contexts. This postgraduate course is for professionals in industry, government and community enterprises seeking to advance their research capabilities.

It is also for graduates seeking a pathway to the MBA Sustainable Enterprise and Higher Degree by Research (HDR). High achieving students may be eligible to progress onto a Masters by Research or PhD, subject to satisfying other criteria and the availability of a supervisor.

This course provides experience in conducting literature and data base reviews, as well as impactful qualitative and quantitative research performed as part of an applied sustainable business research project.

The project components impart understanding in advanced business research concepts, theories, methods and analytical techniques. The course culminates with writing a research proposal for a thesis or substantial business research project.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Successful completion of a recognised bachelor degree, graduate certificate, graduate diploma, master's degree or equivalent international qualification in a business related field, with at least a credit average (GPA 5.0).

Applicants who meet the above in a non-business-related discipline but have at least four years full-time business or research experience in positions of responsibility will also be considered.

Applicants must provide further documentation in the form of a curriculum vitae (CV), documented evidence from your employer detailing roles and responsibilities, and a statement of purpose addressing how the course will help you achieve your career aspirations.

COURSE STRUCTURE

The Graduate Certificate of Business Research is made up of 40 credit points – four core units each worth 10 credit points.
