ABOUT THE COURSE

If you have a bachelor's degree in a field other than education, the Master of Teaching can help you to become a teacher in two years. On graduating, you'll be eligible to register as a teacher in all states and territories in Australia.

Choose the stream that suits your career goals and interests, from early childhood (birth to year 7), primary (transition to year 7) or secondary (year 8 to 12).

The course prepares you for new and changing roles as an educator. You will develop awareness of the environmental and cultural influences on teaching and learning. You'll explore the needs of learners and communities with diverse linguistic and cultural orientations including Indigenous learners. As a teacher, your personal levels of literacy and numeracy will be broadly equivalent to the top 30% of the Australian population.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS FOR INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS
