Small Tutorial Room

Overview

This guide provides basic instructions for the audio visual system. The system features a short-throw, interactive projector and whiteboard. The user can hold presentations from a laptop computer.

Presentation Procedure

Press the **POWER** button to turn the projector on and off. Press the **BLANK** button to blank the display while the projector

is on.

Press the **LAPTOP** button to display a connected laptop.

Press the **WIRELESS** button to display the Wireless Presenter.

Press the **MUTE** button to mute the audio.

Press the **VOL UP** button to increase the volume level.

Press the **VOL DOWN** button to decrease the volume level.

Connecting a Laptop/Document Camera

Connect a laptop or document camera to the 'Laptop' input located underneath the whiteboard using a HDMI cable.

Turn on the Laptop or Document Camera.

Configure the laptop to direct the video image to an external display. E.g. By

selecting Function (Fn) + F3 or F5 or F5 or + P on the laptop.

Consult the laptop's help files for more information.

Use the document camera controls to operate the document camera.
