Student Workload	You will need four (4) units each semester, or eight (8) units for the year. You will need to ensure that your selected study units will be approved by your home university for credit transfer.  A full-time study load at CDU is 40 credit points per semester (10 credit points per unit).

# **APPLICATION PROCESS**

Check if your home university is a CDU partner to find out if you can come to CDU as an exchange student.  Once nominated by your home university, CDU will contact you with the application process.
