

# **PhD Scholarship Opportunity**

Identifying mathematical expression for teaching and learning mathematics in diverse Australian Indigenous languages

**Supervisors:** Dr Cris Edmonds-Wathen

Stipend: \$40,000 yearly for three years (\$120,000) + RTP Fee offset

Location: CDU Casuarina Campus and remote research in NT Aboriginal communities

## **About the Opportunity**

This project is investigating how to use Australian Indigenous languages for teaching primary school mathematics. Part of a multi-site project focusing on several diverse languages, you will work closely and collaboratively with one or more specific schools and language communities. You will describe the ways in which mathematical structures are expressed in the language, how they are used in school mathematics teaching, and additional possibilities for mathematical language use. The aim is to improve remote Indigenous students' access to mathematics in first language and contribute to understanding the relationship between language and mathematics, while working in an interdisciplinary team with linguists and mathematics educators. Dr Cris Edmonds-Wathen has been researching mathematical expression in diverse languages for 15 years, including languages of Australia and Papua New Guinea.

## **Scholarship Details**

The successful applicant will receive a CDU Domestic Excellence Scholarship (CDUDES) (tax-exempt and indexed annually), an RTP Fee Offset for the tuition fees and generous relocation allowances. Find out more about the CDU High impact scholarship opportunities here.
