### I start with Thank you!!!



On the Outskirts of Antioch, C. Cavafi

We in Antioch were astonished when we heard what Julian was up to now.

Apollo had made things clear to him at Daphni: he didn't want to give an oracle (as though we cared!), he didn't intend to speak prophetically, unless his temple at Daphni was purified first.

The nearby dead, he declared, got on his nerves.

There are many tombs at Daphni.

One of those buried there
was the triumphant and holy martyr Vavylas,
wonder and glory of our church.

It was him the false god hinted at, him he feared.
As long as he felt him near he didn't dare
pronounce his oracle: not a murmur.
(The false gods are terrified of our martyrs.)

Unholy Julian got worked up,
lost his temper and shouted: "Raise him, carry him out,
take him away immediately, this Vavylas.
You there, do you hear? He gets on Apollo's nerves.
Grab him, raise him at once,
dig him out, take him away, throw him out,
take him wherever you want. This isn't a joke.
Apollo said the temple has to be purified."

We took it, the holy relic, and carried it elsewhere. We took it, we carried it away in love and in honor.

And hasn't the temple done brilliantly since!
In no time at all a colossal fire
broke out, a terrible fire,
and both the temple and Apollo burned to nothing.

ulian exploded, and he spread it around—
what else could he do?—that we, the Christians,
had set the fire. Let him say so.
It hasn't been proved. Let him say so.
The essential thing is—he exploded.

### **NEW COURSE**

#### ZSC016—CONTEMPORARY GREEK LANGUAGE TEACHING

In October-November 2023 we delivered a professional development course for teachers of Greek Language in Australian Schools as well as in Community Saturday and afternoon schools (enrolments came from NT SA NSW and WA) empowering them with a specifically directed course to enrich their learning and teaching experience. 41 teachers enrolled in the five weeks course in which new practices and tools were introduced to teachers teaching Greek language as second/foreign in Australia.

Το 2023 προσφέραμε έναν νέο κύκλο επιμορφωτικών σεμιναρίων (ZSC016 Contemporary Greek Language Teaching) σε δασκάλες/ους της ελληνικής γλώσσας που διδάσκουν ελληνικά τόσο στο δημόσιο, δηλαδή σε σχολεία αυστραλιανά όσο και σε σχολεία των Κοινοτήτων και της Εκκλησίας.

Αυτό το λίαν επιτυχές εγχείρημα στη Νότια Αυστραλία επιδοτήθηκε από τον οργανισμό *The Foundation for Hellenic Studies* που προσέφερε σε μορφή υποτροφίας τα δίδακτρα σε 30 διδάσκουσες και διδάσκοντες την ελληνική γλώσσα σε σχολεία της Νότιας Αυστραλίας.

Στη Βόρεια Επικράτεια τα δίδακτρα των συμμετεχόντων στα σεμινάρια καλύφτηκαν, για τις/τους διδάσκουσες/ντες στο ελληνικό σχολείο από την Ελληνική Ορθόδοξη Κοινότητα του Ντάργουιν.

Αξίζει να σημειωθεί ότι η επιτυχία των σεμιναρίων οφείλεται τα πλείστα στη συνεργασία του πανεπιστημίου μας με το πανεπιστήμιο του Αιγαίου, το Αριστοτέλειο πανεπιστήμιο Θεσσαλονίκης καθώς και με τις εκδόσεις Neohel, και ειδικότερα την κ. Ευαγγελία Γεωργαντζή.

### **CDU Digital Badges**

Charles Darwin University offers a range of digital badges to recognise learning, experience, skills and knowledge. These are offered by different disciplines across the university.

Badges can also "stack" together to achieve other credentials, or link to pathways for education, employment or career progression.

#### **Earn**

To earn a digital badge you will need to complete a number of activities or tasks, or provide evidence of relevant past achievements. This is known as earning criteria.

Earners will be advised of their achievement via email, and through communication with the coordinator of the specific digital badge.

Earners are able to share their badges with their employers, colleagues and networks on social media.

### Claim

Once earned, digital badges are claimed from Credly's Acclaim platform. Instructions on how to set up you account, and claim and share your badge are sent to each recipient.

For those who like to have printed copies of your achievements, there is printable version available to download for most badges.

### New Greek Badges



This PD course aims to enhance teaching and learning of Greek language and culture by incorporating contemporary approaches and methodologies. Teachers will acquire innovative strategies, techniques, and technologies to improve their instructional prac-

tice, resulting in more effective language acquisition and cultural understanding among students, and will equip teachers with the necessary tools and resources to enhance professional competence in teaching Greek as a second or foreign language.

### **Earning Criteria**

Attendance and participation in three hours of live workshops conducted both online and in-person over the course of four weeks. In addition to the workshop hours, participants will be required to dedicate 8-10 hours to asynchronous learning activities.

- VoiceThread Assignment 1: Demonstrate ability in curriculum update and development
- VoiceThread Assignment 2: Demonstrate ability in current approaches of Greek language
- VoiceThread presentation demonstrating ability in culture as a second and foreign language.

# Greek language training for health and aged care professionals – Step 1.

The next short course is for workers in the health and allied health sector, providing a short course of Greek language and culture to workers in that industry. With an aging community and a clear interest from the related sector (in NT and in South Australia) for a tailored course to meet the needs of the industry and the benefit of the community.



# INVITATION TO REGISTER FOR THE 2024 GREEK EXAMINATIONS

All interested persons are now invited to register for this year's Centre for the Greek Language (CGL) examinations to be held in May at Charles Darwin University (officially recognised CGL Examination Centre).

Prospective candidates of Greek and non-Greek background are invited to test their written and spoken Greek language competency skills through these annual examinations.

Successful candidates will be issued with a *Certificate of Attainment in Greek* from Greece's Ministry of Education and Religious Affairs, and the Centre for the Greek Language: Division for the Support and Promotion of the Greek Language (Thessaloniki, Greece).

There are 7 levels on offer, catering to a full spectrum of Greek language competencies. These include a level for children aged 8-12 years old (children who are *over* 8 years of age and *below* 12 years of age on the 31<sup>st</sup> of May 2024); a level for beginner adolescents and adults, through to a level for persons with excellent knowledge of the Greek language. Candidates younger than 16 are *strongly advised* to avoid taking the examinations for levels B2, C1 and C2 as the examination content for these levels may require general knowledge and experience beyond their years. The full complement of levels on offer is as follows:

- → A1 for children 8-12 years old (Elementary knowledge)
- → A1 for adolescents and adults (Elementary knowledge)
- → A2 (Basic knowledge)
- → **B1** (Intermediate knowledge)
- → B2 (Good knowledge)
- → C1 (Very good knowledge)
- → C2 (Excellent knowledge)

The 2024 CGL Examinations will be held on the following days:

- → Tuesday 14 May for Levels A1 (for children 8-12 years & adolescents and adults) and A2
- → Wednesday 15 May for Levels B2 and C1
- → Thursday 16 May for Levels B1 and C2

Fees have been set by Greece and are as follows:


