

## Outback Active Placement Subsidy - Placement Stipend (no travelling)

### PURPOSE

To provide financial support to the Bachelor of Exercise and Sport Science (WESS01/ WESS02) students allocated to an Outback Active placement.

Outback Active is a digital exercise program led by CDU Health Hub, for people 65+ years, and First Nations people 50+ years living in the Katherine region, to help them stay strong, healthy and mobile.

Outback Active is a 4-to-5-week placement that offers a unique opportunity to develop professional skills in a supportive, multi-disciplinary setting, while gaining experience in digital health and making a real impact in the community.

### ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- > Must be currently studying Bachelor of Exercise and Sport Science (WESS01/ WESS02) at CDU.
- > Must be enrolled in and completing placement(s) for one of the following units:
  - SPE 315
  - SPE 405
- > Must be allocated a placement with Outback Active

### SELECTION CRITERIA

Essential

- > Interest in the Outback Active program ([go.cdu.edu.au/outbackactive](http://go.cdu.edu.au/outbackactive))
- > Interest OR experience working with older people
- > Outline future plans and ambitions in the field of Exercise and Sport Science

## PAYMENT OF BENEFITS

- > Each recipient will be paid by electronic funds transfer to their nominated bank account.
- > A one-off full payment will be made upon completion of the placement.
- > Payments are subject to the recipient satisfying ongoing eligibility criteria as outlined in this document.

## DURATION

The duration of the Subsidy is one (1) semester or when one of the following is true:

- > The maximum Subsidy value has been exhausted;
- > The student has completed their course of study;
- > The student no longer meets the ongoing eligibility of the Subsidy.

## SELECTION

Selection and awarding will take place when suitable nominations are received. Offers will be authorised by the Faculty. The decision of the Faculty is final and cannot be overturned.

## OBLIGATIONS AND CONDITIONS:

- > The recipient must continue to be enrolled in the course, unit and placement under which the Subsidy was granted.
- > The offer of the Subsidy is made subject to information provided by the recipient being true and accurate.
- > By accepting the offer of the Subsidy, each recipient agrees to the Subsidy Terms and Conditions.
- > The recipient is responsible for advising their lecturer of any changes in circumstances that would make them ineligible for continuation of the subsidy, e.g. terminating placements.

## TERMINATION/RETURN OF SUBSIDY

The Subsidy will need to be returned:

- > If the recipient ceases to meet the eligibility criteria; or
- > If the recipient withdraws from their unit; or
- > If the recipient does not complete the required placement hours in the relevant units; or
- > If the recipient breaches any conditions of the Subsidy; or
- > If CDU determines that the student is guilty of serious misconduct; or
- > If the student fails to meet the preclinical requirements of the placement.
