

CDU CASUARINA OPEN DAY DISCOVERY TRAIL PROMOTION

Terms and Conditions of Entry

These Terms and Conditions ("Terms") govern participation in the CDU Casuarina Open Day Discovery Trail promotion ("Promotion") conducted by Charles Darwin University ABN 54 093 513 649 of Ellengowan Drive, Brinkin NT 0810 ("University", "we", "us" or "our"). By collecting stamps, completing the trail, or submitting a completed trail card for entry, a participant ("you" or "participant") agrees to be bound by these Terms.

1. Promotion Period and Location

- a) The Promotion runs only during the CDU Casuarina Open Day event held on Saturday 8 August 2026 between 10am and 4pm ACST ("Promotion Period") at the Casuarina campus, Ellengowan Drive, Brinkin NT 0810 ("Campus").
- b) Entries, trail cards, or stamps obtained outside the Promotion Period or outside the Campus will not be accepted.
- c) The University reserves the right to vary the Promotion Period (including start and finish times) due to weather, safety, or operational requirements, and will make reasonable efforts to notify attendees of any change via on-campus signage and staff announcements.

2. Eligibility

- a) The Promotion is open to all individuals attending the CDU Casuarina Open Day, subject to clause 2b) and clause 8 (Participants Under 18).
- b) The following persons are not eligible to enter or win the prize draw: (a) employees, contractors, and volunteers of the University who are directly involved in the administration, judging, or conduct of the Promotion; and (b) immediate family members (spouse, partner, parent, child, or sibling) of those persons.
- c) Each individual may submit only one completed trail card and receive only one entry into the prize draw, regardless of the number of trail cards collected.
- d) Entries that are incomplete, illegible, damaged, altered, falsified, or not submitted in accordance with these Terms may be deemed invalid at the University's discretion.

3. How to Enter

- a) To be eligible for entry into the prize draw, a participant must, during the Promotion Period: (a) collect a physical trail card from a designated CDU Casuarina Open Day information point; (b) visit each designated location on the Campus and collect the corresponding stamp on the trail card; (c) once all stamps have been collected, present the fully completed trail card to University staff at the designated collection point; and (d) provide the contact and identification details reasonably requested by University staff for the purpose of the prize draw (and, if applicable, parent/guardian consent under clause 8).
- b) Upon verification by University staff that a trail card is fully and genuinely completed, the participant will receive one entry into the prize draw.
- c) Entry into the Promotion is free and no purchase is necessary.
- d) The University's decision as to whether a trail card is complete and valid is final.

4. The Prize

- a) One (1) prize is available to be won: a Velectrix Cruiser Step Through Bicycle with an approximate total retail value of AUD \$2,500 ("Prize").
- b) The Prize is as described by the University and cannot be exchanged, transferred to another person, or redeemed for cash, in whole or in part, except at the University's sole discretion.
- c) If the specified Prize (or a component of it) becomes unavailable for reasons outside the University's reasonable control, the University reserves the right to substitute the Prize with another item of equal or greater value.

5. Prize Draw and Winner Selection

- a) The prize draw will be conducted after the close of the Promotion Period, at 2:45pm at CDU Open Day Main Stage, using a random drawing method (for example, a random number generator or physical draw from all valid entries).
- b) The draw will be conducted, and the result verified, by a University staff member or contractor who is not otherwise involved in delivering the Promotion.
- c) The winner will be selected at random from all valid entries received. No skill or judgement is involved in determining the winner.
- d) The University's decision in relation to any aspect of the Promotion, including the conduct of the draw and identification of the winner, is final and binding, and no correspondence will be entered into except as required by law.

6. Notification and Collection of Prize

- a) The winner will be notified using the contact details provided at the time of entry, within 5 days of the draw.
- b) The winner (or, where clause 8 applies, their parent or guardian) may be required to provide proof of identity and eligibility before the Prize is released.
- c) If the winner cannot be contacted within 5 days of the first attempt, or does not claim the Prize within 5 days of notification, the University reserves the right to select an alternate winner by way of a further random draw from the remaining valid entries, or to deal with the Prize as permitted by any applicable law.
- d) The Prize must be collected from Charles Darwin University Casuarina Campus by 21 August 2026, unless alternative arrangements are agreed with the University.

7. Personal Information and Privacy

- a) The University will collect personal information from participants (and, where applicable, from a parent or guardian) for the purposes of administering the Promotion, including conducting the draw, contacting and verifying the winner, and complying with any legal or reporting obligations.
- b) By entering this competition, you consent to the University contacting you with marketing information about studying at CDU. You may unsubscribe from these communications at any time. Please refer to our [Privacy Policy](#) for details on how your personal information is handled.

8. Participants Under 18 Years of Age

- a) Individuals under the age of 18 may participate in the Promotion and enter the prize draw, but must have the consent of a parent or legal guardian to do so.
- b) Before a trail card can be accepted for entry, a participant under 18 must have their trail card co-signed, or consent otherwise confirmed in a manner acceptable to the University (such as a signed consent form or a parent/guardian being present at submission), by a parent or legal guardian who agrees to these Terms on the minor's behalf.
- c) If a participant under 18 is selected as the winner, the Prize will only be released to, or collected in the presence of, the participant's parent or legal guardian, who must also provide proof of their relationship to the winner and their own identification if requested.
- d) The University may, at its discretion, decline to accept an entry from a participant under 18 where parental or guardian consent cannot be verified.
- e) Parents and guardians are responsible for supervising minors while participating in the Promotion around the Campus.

9. Liability and Release

- a) Participation in the Promotion, including walking around the Campus to collect stamps, is undertaken at the participant's own risk.
- b) To the maximum extent permitted by law, the University excludes all liability for any loss, damage, injury, or expense (including but not limited to personal injury, loss of property, or consequential loss) arising out of or in connection with participation in the Promotion or acceptance or use of the Prize, except to the extent such liability cannot be excluded by law (including under the Australian Consumer Law).
- c) Nothing in these Terms is intended to exclude, restrict, or modify any consumer guarantee, right, or remedy conferred on a participant under the Australian Consumer Law or other applicable law that cannot lawfully be excluded, restricted, or modified.
- d) The University is not responsible for any technical failure, lost, late, misdirected, or illegible entries, or for any injury or damage to a participant's or any other person's property that may be related to or result from participation in the Promotion.

10. General Conditions

- a) The University reserves the right, at any time, to verify the validity of entries and participants (including a participant's identity, age, and compliance with these Terms) and to disqualify any participant who submits an entry not in accordance with these Terms or who engages in conduct that is fraudulent, unlawful, or otherwise inconsistent with the spirit of the Promotion.
- b) The University reserves the right to cancel, suspend, or amend the Promotion, or these Terms, without notice, if a cause outside its reasonable control (including but not limited to industrial action, extreme weather, or a threat to safety) makes it necessary to do so, subject to any written directions issued by an applicable regulatory authority.
- c) These Terms are governed by the laws of the Northern Territory of Australia, and participants submit to the non-exclusive jurisdiction of the courts of the Northern Territory of Australia.
- d) A reference to "University staff" includes authorised volunteers assisting with the conduct of the Promotion.
