PURPOSE

Consistent with the Company's values, Santos is committed to supporting the education of future engineering professionals through financial awards and development opportunities. This scholarship has been established to reward high-performing students interested in pursuing a career in the energy industry and may consider Santos as an employer upon graduation.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- > Must be enrolled in the Bachelor of Engineering Science, Bachelor of Engineering Honours, Bachelor of Engineering Science/Master of Engineering or the Master of Engineering
- > Must be enrolled full-time for the duration of the scholarship - i.e. enrolled in 30 credit points or more in the current semester
- > Must be an Australian or New Zealand citizen, or holder of an Australian permanent resident visa or permanent humanitarian visa
- > Must be a current resident of the Northern Territory
- > Must not be a current recipient of any other industry-sponsored scholarships

SELECTION CRITERIA

Essential

- > Demonstrate an appropriate academic record (ATAR > 81 or GPA 5.0)
- > Provide reasons for choosing your area of study and details of your future plans and ambitions, including employment goals
- > Provide two references

Desirable

- > Female students and/or First Nations students are encouraged to apply

Scholarship terms and conditions

PAYMENT OF BENEFITS

- > Each recipient will be paid by electronic funds transfer to their nominated bank account.
- > Payment will be made after the Census dates in Semester 1 and/or Semester 2.
- > Payments are subject to the recipient satisfying ongoing eligibility criteria as outlined in this document and the Donor Scholarship Policy.

DURATION

The duration of the Scholarship is two (2) semesters or when one of the following is true:

- > The maximum Scholarship value has been exhausted;
- > The student has completed their course of study;
- > The student no longer meets the ongoing eligibility of the Scholarship.

A recipient who commences the Scholarship part way through their course may not receive the full Scholarship amount. This is also true for recipients who do not follow a usual full-time study load. The total value of the Scholarship may be exhausted prior to completion.

SELECTION

Eligible applications will be presented to a Selection Committee shortly after the scholarship closing date. Offers will be authorised by the Chair of the Selection Committee in line with the Donor Scholarship Policy.

ONGOING ELIGIBILITY

Academic progress

Higher Education: The recipient must maintain an overall minimum credit average (GPA of 5.0) for the duration of their scholarship.

The recipient must pass 50% or more of their enrolled load in a progression period and not fail the same unit two (2) or more times.

CDU Enrolment:

The recipient:

- > must continue to be enrolled in the required study load in the course under which the Scholarship was granted at CDU; or
- > If the recipient has an approved course transfer, they may apply to the Scholarships officer to transfer the Scholarship to the new course. If the Scholarship transfer is approved, all previous Scholarship payments will accumulate towards the total payments received.

Intermission:

- > If the recipient is granted intermission for the semester, payment of the Scholarship will be suspended.
- > A Scholarship can be suspended for a maximum of two (2) semesters. This may include:
 - o One (1) or two (2) semesters of approved intermissions; or
 - o One (1) semester of approved intermission and one (1) semester of suspension on the grounds of failure to meet ongoing eligibility criteria

Other obligations and conditions:

- > The offer of the Scholarship is made subject to information provided by the recipient being true and accurate.
- > By accepting the offer of the Scholarship, each recipient agrees to the Scholarship Terms and Conditions.
- > The recipient is responsible for advising the Scholarships Officer of any changes in circumstances that would make them ineligible for continuation of the Scholarship, e.g. reducing study load to part-time, applying for an intermission or transferring to another course.

TERMINATION OF RECIPIENT'S SCHOLARSHIP

The Scholarship will terminate:

- > If the recipient ceases to meet the eligibility criteria; or
- > If the recipient fails to meet the ongoing eligibility criteria for two (2) teaching periods; or
- > If the recipient withdraws from their course; or
- > If the recipient breaches any conditions of the Scholarship; or
- > If CDU determines that the student is guilty of serious misconduct
