CPP is a government program that offers financial support to students while undertaking mandatory placements. This support will enable them to gain practical experience and develop professional competence without feeling financial stress.

Receive **\$338.60** per week

Who can apply?

- ✓ Domestic students studying in a Commonwealth Supported Place
- ✓ Must meet eligibility requirements
- ✓ Available for courses in Nursing, Midwifery, Teaching and Social Work with mandatory placements
- ✓ Completing your placement on a full-time basis (minimum of 30 hours per week)

What can it help with?

- ✓ Travel and accommodation costs
- ✓ Study materials and uniforms
- ✓ Living expenses

How to Apply



1. Enrol

Once your placement dates are confirmed in InPlace, you'll receive the email invitation from MyCPP



2. Apply

Submit your application with supporting documentation and enter your bank details in MyStudentInfo



3. Wait

Your application can take up to 10 days to be assessed, so make sure to apply well before your placement commencement



4. Approval

If approved – payments will be made on a fortnightly basis
