# TO PREPARE FOR YOUR ASSIGNMENT

1

Attend Orientation Week activities on academic skills, referencing and plagiarism to make sure you are ready to begin your studies!

2

Build your academic skills, by attending free ALLSP and library workshops. These will help you understand how to research and write at university!

3

Clarify what the assessment task is and what is expected of you. Your lecturer is always willing to help and ALLSP can also assist.

4

You should plan a regular daily and weekly pattern of study!

5

Seek help early if you need it. Obstacles can and will happen while you are studying. Get help as soon as you can. If the issue is to do with your course, speak to your lecturer but for other areas, CDU offer a number of support areas.

6

Check if your assessment demonstrates academic integrity. Academic integrity is important. Make sure your writing displays honest, ethical and respectful behaviour.

7

Know how to submit your assignment in Learnline. Issues with assessment submission can be avoided if you know how to submit. Complete the Learnline Student Orientation Unit.
