Download from Software center



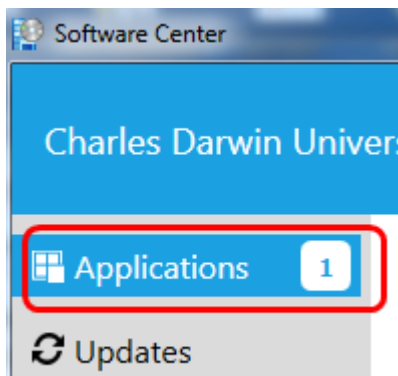
Step 1: Click the Start Menu

Downloading Google Chrome browser

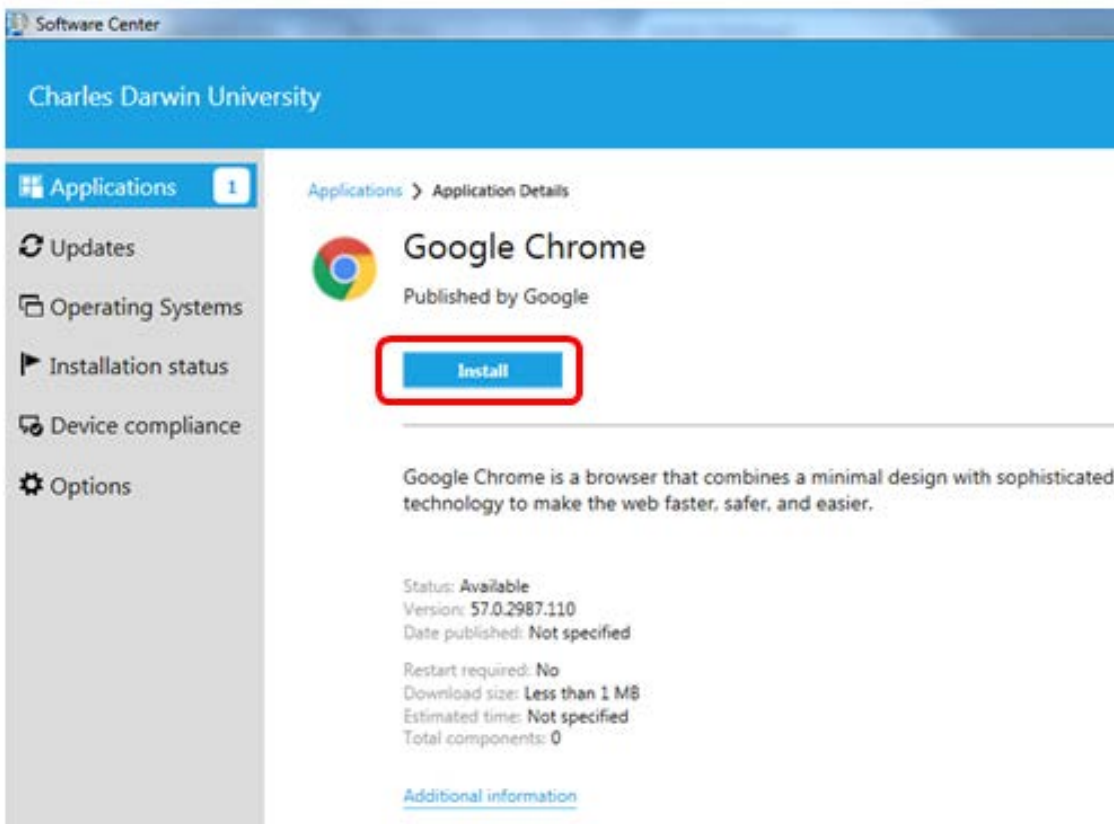


Step 1: Click 'Application' tab

Step 2: Click 'Google chrome icon



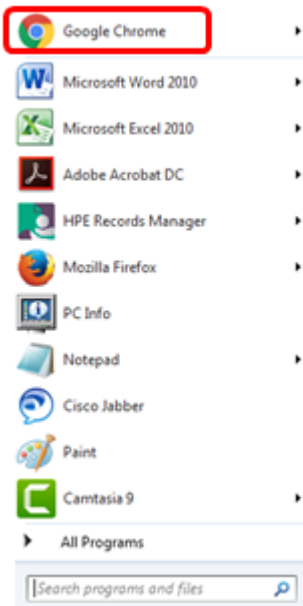
Step3: Click 'Install'

Option 1: the above screen will now show

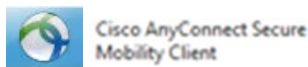
If the application does not successfully install, contact ITMS on ext. 6600.

Opening the Java Web Start Launcher for the first time

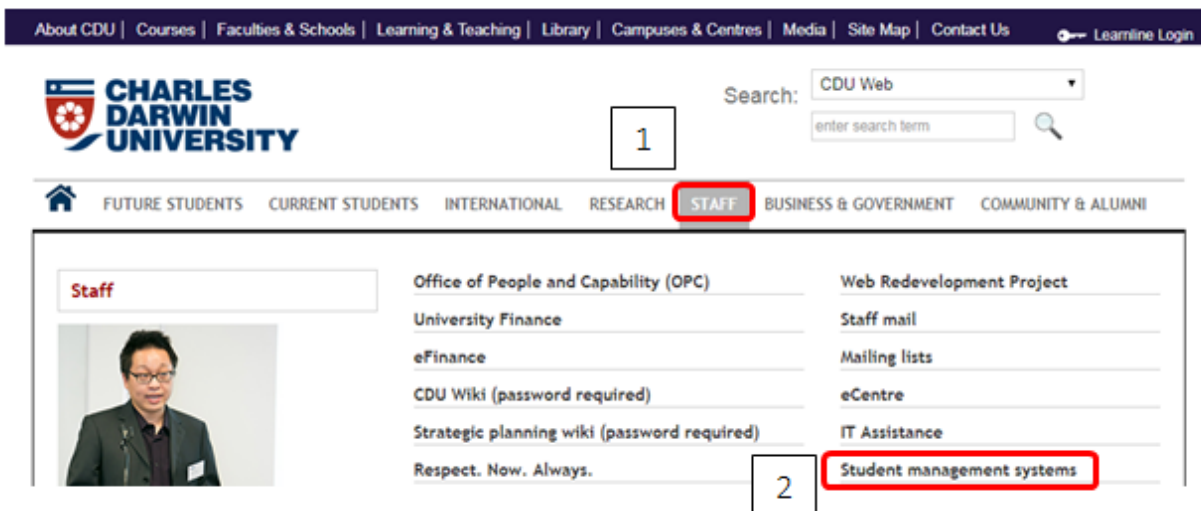
Step 1: Log onto Cisco AnyConnect.

Step 3: In the browser field type www.cdu.edu.au

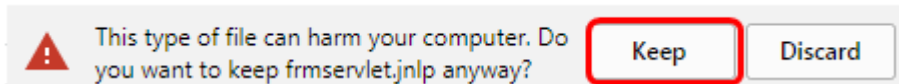


Step 4: Hover over 'Staff' tab

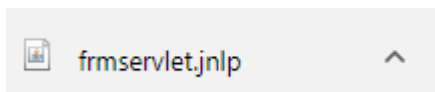
Step 5: Click 'Student Management Systems'



Step 6: Click 'Callista login'

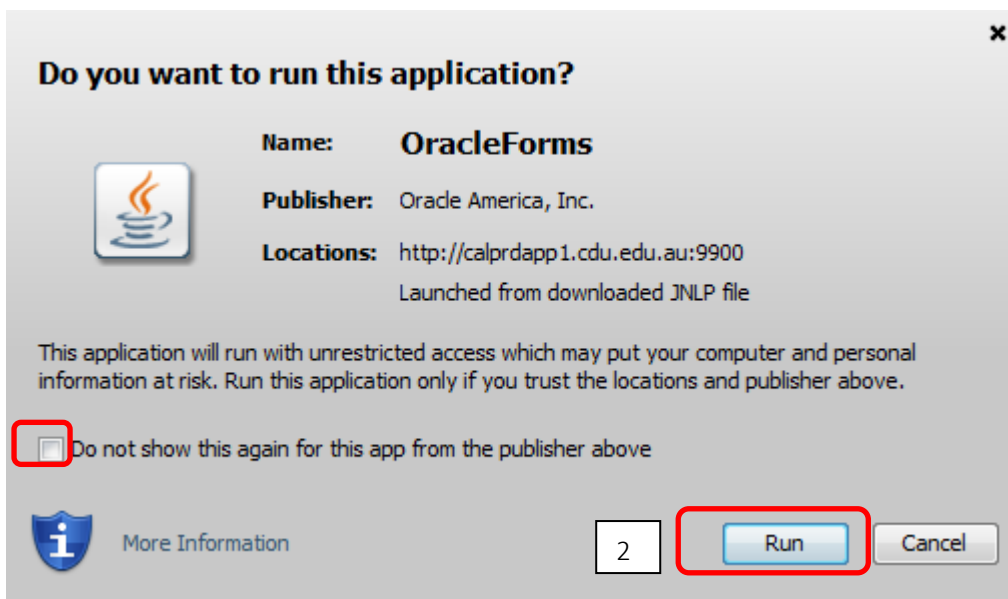


Step 7: Click 'Keep'



Step 8: Click on the 'frmervlet.jnlp icon'



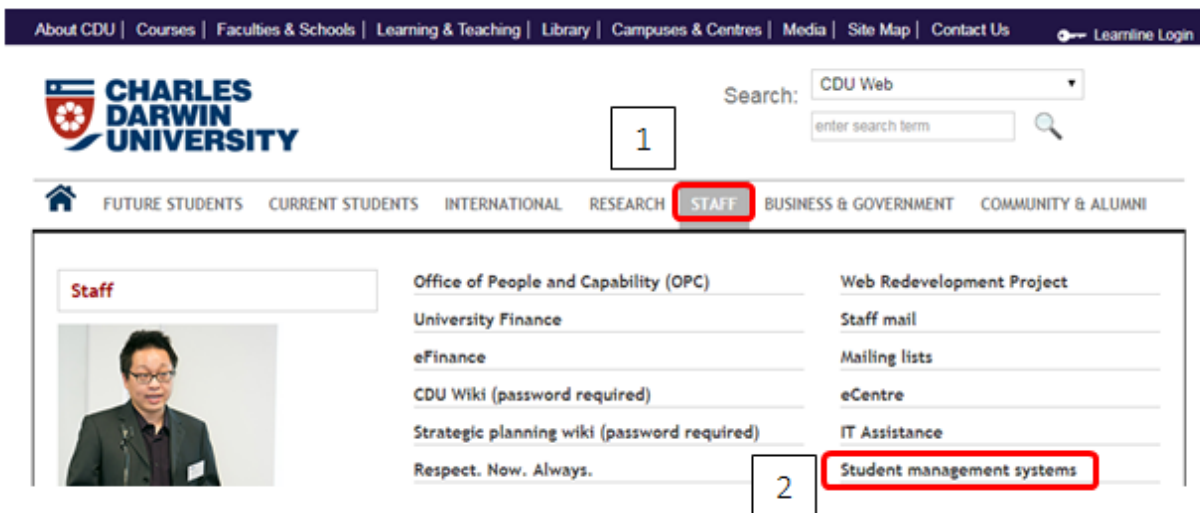
Opening the Java Web Start Launcher subsequent times

Step 3: In the browser field type www.cdu.edu.au

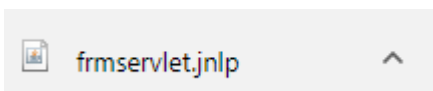


Step 4: Hover over 'Staff' tab

Step 6: Click 'Callista login'




Step 7: Click on the 'frmServlet.jnlp' icon'
