# Senior Indigenous Community-Based Researcher

### ABOUT THE CREDENTIAL

The Senior Indigenous Community-Based Researcher credential is available to senior Indigenous researchers with significant previous experience in community based cross-cultural research. It recognises strong cultural authority in the conduct of research projects, and an accumulation of prior achievement. Recipients of this credential demonstrate strong bilingual and cross-cultural research competency, and high level skills in research co-design and public communication.

### ELIGIBILITY

This credential is available to Indigenous researchers who can demonstrate significant previous experience carrying out research projects in the Northern Territory.

### AWARD CRITERIA

This credential can be awarded on the completion of a research profile or portfolio detailing:

- > Who you are, and your previous work or research experience
- > Examples of 3 or more completed research projects, including
  - Brief project description
  - Identification of skills practiced
  - Any available photos or videos
  - Reflection on the research outcomes

### ASSESSMENT

Assessment will be carried out by a CDU researcher and/or an appropriate senior Indigenous authority.
