

Realist Research and Evaluation FIVE DAY INTENSIVE WORKSHOP

30 September - 4 October 2019

(La Trobe University, Melbourne)

This intensive workshop will introduce participants to the philosophical assumptions of a realist philosophy of science and their implications for understanding how policies and programs work. Participants will develop skills in designing and implementing realist research and evaluation, from developing initial questions through to final reporting. The workshop also covers realist review, the realist approach to systematic literature reviews and rapid realist review. Accreditation at Masters level is available. An additional fee for marking of papers may apply for students outside the Master of Public Policy program.

This workshop is available to researchers and evaluators in other organisations and departments; to commissioners of research and evaluation; Master of Public Policy students; post-graduate students from any university; and staff who want to develop new research and evaluation skills.
